LOCATION

EEC-ITIS is located in San Gwann, an authentic Maltese town close to Sliema and St Julian's, and well connected to Valletta.

CLASSROOMS

Each classroom is designed around a unique theme and decorated accordingly. With comfortable desks and chairs, a multimedia system, and interactive whiteboard, our rooms provide a positive learning environment for all students.

COURSES AT EEC-ITIS

GENERAL ENGLISH

20 lessons (15 hours) per week

Summary

Our general English programme uses a blended learning approach that takes advantage of our online portal so that students can study before their lessons, in class, and after their lessons.

We use a moderate communicative approach that balances fluency with grammatical knowledge and vocabulary so that students can develop the skills needed to communicate in a variety of everyday situations.

We recognise that students progress at their own pace so we let students choose which topics and target language to focus on to ensure their unique needs are met.

Eligibility

This course is available to all students who are **18 and over**.

Schedule

Classes are held at the following times:

9.00 to 12.15

or

13.00 to 16.15

Note: EEC-ITIS operates an extended hours policy during weeks containing a public holiday. In these instances, lessons are extended by 45 minutes each day.

Assessment

Students are assessed prior to commencement of their studies to ensure that they are placed into the correct level. Additionally, we administer progress tests and end of course tests, and provide a certificate of attendance/completion once a student has completed their studies.

INTENSIVE ENGLISH

20+10 lessons (22.5 hours) per week

Summary

For students who want additional speaking practice in a relaxed environment, this programme combines the general English programme with additional afternoon classes.

In the morning, students follow the general English syllabus, and in the afternoon, students discuss interesting topics with their classmates to develop their fluency and receive additional feedback.

While the morning classes blend grammar, vocabulary, and speaking, developing all 4 skills, the conversation classes let students talk more freely and provide them with useful idioms, phrases, and functional language.

This course is available to all students who are **18 and over**.

Classes are held at the following times:

9.00 to 12.15

then

13.00 to 14.30

Note: EEC-ITIS operates an extended hours policy during weeks containing a public holiday. In these instances, morning lessons are extended by 45 minutes each day, and afternoon classes are extended by 25 minutes.

Students are assessed prior to commencement of their studies to ensure that they are placed into the correct level. Additionally, we administer progress tests and end of course tests, and provide a certificate of attendance/completion once a student has completed their studies.



IELTS EXAM PREPARATION (FULL)

20+10 lessons (22.5 hours) per week

Summary

This course combines general English with IELTS exam preparation, so that students have the skills and confidence needed to succeed in the IELTS exam and achieve their desired band score.

Morning lessons cover a variety of general English topics such as those found in the speaking and listening sections of the IELTS exam. This allows them to develop the language and fluency skills needed to tackle these sections with confidence.

In the afternoon, students explore IELTS specific language, review the exam skills needed, and undertake guided practices with one of our expert IELTS instructors.

Eligibility

This course is available to all students who are **18 and over** with a **minimum language proficiency of B1** (according to the CEFR).

Schedule

Classes are held at the following times:

9.00 to 12.15

then

13.00 to 14.30

Note: EEC-ITIS operates an extended hours policy during weeks containing a public holiday. In these instances, morning lessons are extended by 45 minutes each day, and afternoon classes are extended by 25 minutes.

Assessment

Students are assessed prior to commencement of their studies to ensure that they are placed into the correct level. Additionally, we administer progress tests and end of course tests, and provide a certificate of attendance/completion once a student has completed their studies.

IELTS EXAM PREPARATION (SKILLS ONLY)

4 hours per week for 4 weeks (16 hours in total)

Summary

Specifically designed for working professionals or students who reside permanently in Malta, this course guides students through all 4 sections of the IELTS exam, with a focus on exam skills and IELTS specific grammar, functional language, and vocabulary.

This course is perfect for those planning to study, emigrate or work abroad and require an IELTS band score to meet immigration or university entry requirements.

Eligibility

This course is available to all students who are **18 and over** with a **minimum language proficiency of B2** (according to the CEFR).

Schedule

Classes are held at the following times:

Option 1: Tuesday and Thursday - 17.30 to 19.30

or

Option 2: Wednesday and Friday - 17.30 to 19.30

or

Option 3: Saturday - 10.00 to 12.00, and Monday - 17.30 to 19.30

Assessment

Students are assessed prior to commencement of their studies to ensure that they are placed into the correct level. Additionally, we administer progress tests and end of course tests, and provide a certificate of attendance/completion once a student has completed their studies.



CAMBRIDGE EXAM PREPARATION

20+10 lessons (22.5 hours) per week

Summary

From the Cambridge exam suite, we offer exam preparation courses for the Cambridge First (B2) exam, and the Cambridge Advanced (C1) exam.

This course combines our general English programme with exam preparation, so that students can approach all sections of the exam with the skills necessary to succeed.

In the morning, students will participate in classes where they'll practise all 4 English skills while exploring a variety of everyday day topics, such as those found in the Cambridge exams. In the afternoon, students will work closely with classmates and one of our expert Cambridge exam preparation teachers, who will guide them through authentic exam practices.

Eligibility

This course is available to all students who are **18 and over**.

ENGLISH FOR SPECIFIC PURPOSES: ONE TO ONE

20+10 lessons (22.5 hours) per week

Summary

For students with a more specific language goal, we offer one-to-ones combined with general English. While the general English lessons cover a variety of everyday topics, suited to your specific language ability, the one-to-ones are tailored to suit your unique objective.

Whether it's preparing for an interview, improving your presentation skills, or developing your job-specific language skills, we can design a one-to-one programme that will meet your requirements.

Note: While we are happy to provide specific study materials, where possible, we ask students to provide us with any relevant materials they wish to study in their one-to-one classes.

Eligibility

This course is available to all students who are **18 and over**.

Classes are held at the following times:

9.00 to 12.15

then

13.00 to 14.30

ONE-TO-ONES

5 lessons (4.75 hours) or
10 Lessons (7.5 hours)

Summary

For students who like individual attention, we offer one-to-one lessons, lasting either 45 minutes or 90 minutes.

Unlike our English for Specific Purpose one-to-ones, these lessons adhere to a set curriculum that follows the general English programme, while allowing students to choose the topics they found more challenging. This allows students to explore them in greater detail, while benefiting from additional feedback and support.

Eligibility

This course is available to all students who are **18 and over**.

Schedule

Classes are held at one of the following times depending on the time of year and the needs of the student.

5 lessons:

or

Note: EEC-ITIS operates an extended hours policy during weeks containing a public holiday. In these instances, morning lessons are extended by 45 minutes each day, and afternoon classes are extended by 25 minutes for 90 minute lessons and 15 minutes for 45 minute lessons.

Students are assessed prior to commencement of their studies to ensure that they are placed into the correct level. Additionally, we administer progress tests and end of course tests, and provide a certificate of attendance/completion once a student has completed their studies.

COMBINATION: ONE-TO-ONES

20+5 lessons (18.75 hours) or
20+10 Lessons (22.5 hours)

Summary

Attending group lessons is a fantastic way to practise all four language skills by participating in pair and group activities, discussing interesting topics, and working together on projects. Moreover, it's a great way to make some new friends! However, we know that some students benefit from some extra one-to-one time with their teacher, where they can receive individual attention, support, and feedback.

This course combines our general English programme with either 5 or 10 one-to-ones each week.

Eligibility

This course is available to all students who are **18 and over**.

Classes are held at one of the following times depending on the time of year and needs of the student.

General English: 9.00 to 12.15

and

5 one-to-ones: 8.00 to 8.45, 13.00 to 13.45, or 13.50 to 14.35

30 lessons (22.5 hours) per week

Summary

Throughout this program, attendees will be introduced to the latest advancements in educational technology, gaining insights on how to elevate their teaching methods. Participants will look into the utilisation of digital technology within and beyond the classroom, explore blended learning strategies, and investigate the integration of artificial intelligence for enhanced lessons.

Designed for educators across all disciplines, this course offers the opportunity to enhance English language skills while exploring diverse and engaging topics. Whether the aim is to select optimal online resources, craft digital teaching materials, or master the use of learning management systems, the course provides guidance on effectively implementing the most recent technological innovations in education.

Eligibility

This course is available to **teachers of any subject** with a **minimum language proficiency of B1** (according to the CEFR).

ERASMUS TEACHER TRAINING: CLIL FOR PRIMARY SCHOOL TEACHERS

30 lessons (22.5 hours) per week

Summary

The Content and Language Integrated Learning (CLIL) teacher training course is designed to equip educators with essential skills and methodologies for effective integration of language and subject matter in their classrooms. Each day, participants focus on practical strategies to seamlessly blend language instruction with the content of their specific subject areas. The course begins by establishing a theoretical foundation, delving into the principles of CLIL and its impact on student learning. Subsequent sessions provide hands-on activities, lesson planning exercises, and collaborative discussions that empower teachers to design and implement CLIL-based lessons. Over the five days, the CLIL teacher training course emphasizes a gradual and scaffolded approach to integration, ensuring that educators are well-equipped to adapt these techniques to their unique teaching contexts.

The course culminates in a collaborative project where participants apply their newfound knowledge and skills to create a CLIL lesson plan tailored to their specific subject area.

Summary

This course combines a theoretical overview of CLIL principles with hands-on activities and collaborative discussions, focusing on practical strategies for effective implementation. Throughout the training, teachers explore diverse instructional materials, assessment techniques, and language scaffolding tools to elevate both language proficiency and content comprehension in their classrooms. In their final collaborative project, teachers create a tailored CLIL lesson plan for their specific subject area, ensuring they are well-prepared to apply these techniques in their unique teaching contexts. By the end of the training, secondary school educators are equipped to enhance their students' learning experiences by integrating language skills with subject content effectively.

Eligibility

This course is available to **secondary school teachers** with a **minimum language proficiency of A2** (according to the CEFR).

LANGUAGE

During their time with EEC -ITIS, participants will take part in engaging **English** lessons where they can improve their speaking skills under the guidance of expert language teachers.

In class, students will participate in fun activities and complete projects that encourage them to use their **speaking, reading, writing,** and **listening** skills, while getting to know their classmates.

As well as English, participants will also have a chance to study **German** and **Spanish**, so they can become expert global citizens.

Our course leaders will take them on outings so they can visit some of the island's fascinating museums, including **the National Museum of Natural History**, and the **National Museum of Archeology**.
